"20-25-306. Designation of holidays by board of 8 9 regents. (1) The board of regents of higher education may 10 designate the following business days as holidays for all 11 employees of the university system in exchange for the same 12

number of legal holidays enumerated in 1-1-216:

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(b)(a) the Monday before Christmas Day or New Year's 14 15 Day if either holiday falls on Tuesday; and

16 fc+(b) the Friday after Christmas Day or New Year's 17 Day if either holiday falls on Thursday.

(2) A full-time employee who is scheduled for a day 18 19 off on a day that is designated as a holiday under subsection (1) is entitled to receive another day off with 20 pay during the same pay period of the designated holiday or 21 as scheduled by the employee and his supervisor in addition 22 23 to the employee's regularly scheduled days off provided the employee is in a pay status on his last regularly scheduled 24 25 working day immediately before the holiday or on his first

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regularly scheduled working day immediately after the
 holiday. Part-time employees receive pay for the designated
 holiday on a prorated basis according to rules adopted by
 the department of administration or appropriate
 administrative officer under 2-18-604."
