A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING THE MONTANA  
COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL AND  
PRACTICAL FOREST RESOURCE EDUCATION AND INFORMATION TO  
INTERESTED PERSONS; PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THAT  
PURPOSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Cooperative extension service to provide forestry education program. The Montana cooperative extension service shall provide technical and practical education to interested persons concerning forest woodlot management, range, soil, and water conservation, and the establishment and maintenance of woodlots, windbreaks, and shelterbelts. The Montana cooperative extension service shall cooperate with all public and other agencies to develop and disseminate educational programs to protect and manage forest, range, and water resources.

Section 2. Appropriation. The following money is appropriated from the general fund to the Montana Cooperative Extension Service to provide forest education:

Fiscal year ending June 30, 1986	\$62,710
Fiscal year ending June 30, 1987	\$56,613
