 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT
 6 VIOLATION OF THE FEDERAL DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL
 7 ACT IS GROUNDS FOR REVOCATION OF A PHARMACIST'S LICENSE;
 8 AMENDING SECTION 37-7-311, MCA."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 37-7-311, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "37-7-311. Revocation of license issued to pharmacist
13 or intern. The board shall revoke licenses issued by the
14 department to a pharmacist or intern whenever the holder of
15 the license:

16 (1) has obtained it by false representations or fraud;

17 (2) is an habitual drunkard or addicted to the use of
18 narcotic drugs;

19 (3) has been convicted of violating the Federal Food,
20 Drug, and Cosmetic Act (Title 21, chapter 9, U.S.C.); the
21 Federal Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Act (Title 21,
22 chapter 13, subchapter 1, U.S.C.); chapter 2 or 7 of Title
23 37, chapter 9 or 10 of Title 45, or chapter 31 or 32 of
24 Title 50, MCA; or rules adopted under such act or chapters;
25 or

1 (4) has been found by the board guilty of incompetency
 2 in the preparation of prescriptions or guilty of gross
 3 immorality affecting the discharge of his duties as a
 4 pharmacist or intern."
 5 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
 6 existing authority of the board of pharmacy to make rules on
 7 the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the
 8 provisions of this act.
