A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH, WILDLIFE, AND PARKS THE OPTION OF HERDING WILD ANIMALS CAUSING DAMAGE OFF THE LANDOWNER'S PROPERTY: AMENDING SECTION 87-1-225, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 87-1-225, MCA, is amended to read: \*87-1-225. Regulation of wild animals damaging property. Upon the request or complaint of any landholder or person in possession and having charge of any land in the state that wild animals of the state, protected by the fish and game laws and regulations, are doing damage to the property or crops thereon, the department shall investigate and study the situation with respect to damage and depredation. The department may then decide to herd the animals off the property, open a special season on the game, or, if the special season method be not feasible, the department may destroy the animals causing the damage. department may authorize and grant the holders of said property permission to kill or destroy a specified number of the animals causing the damage. The department may not herd the animals onto the real property of another without first



obtaining written permission of the owner, his agent,

lessee, or person in possession. No wild ferocious animal

damaging property or endangering life shall be covered by

this section."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and
parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this
