 6 SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION MUST RECEIVE A COPY OF
 7 ALL SCHOOL DISTRICT AUDITS; AMENDING SECTION 20-9-203, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 20-9-203, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "20-9-203. Examination of district accounting records.

12 (1) The accounting records of all first- and second-class
 13 school districts and third-class school districts that
 14 maintain a high school shall be audited in accordance with
 15 2-7-503.

16 (2) Annually and at such other times as directed by
 17 the board of county commissioners or trustees, the county
 18 auditor or the county treasurer if there is no county
 19 auditor shall audit the accounting records of each
 20 third-class district that does not maintain a high school.
 21 Such district shall deliver all accounting records to the
 22 auditing county official no later than July 15 for the audit
 23 of the financial activity of the last completed school
 24 fiscal year. The auditing county official shall examine the
 25 accounting records, prepare an audit report, and:

1 (a) return the accounting records to the district no
 2 later than August 15;
 3 (b) send a copy of the audit report to the chairman of
 4 the trustees; and
 5 (c) file copies of the audit report with the
 6 superintendent of public instruction, the county
 7 superintendent, and the county clerk and recorder."
