10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA;

11 Section 1. Section 18-4-221, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "18-4-221. General procurement authority and duties of  
13 department -- rules. (1) Except as otherwise provided in  
14 this chapter, the department shall adopt rules, consistent  
15 with this chapter, governing the procurement and disposal of  
16 any and all supplies and services to be procured by the  
17 state. The department shall consider and decide matters of  
18 policy within the provisions of this chapter. The department  
19 may audit and monitor the implementation of its rules and  
20 the requirements of this chapter.

21 (2) Except as otherwise specifically provided by law,  
22 the department shall, in accordance with its rules:

23 (a) procure or supervise the procurement of all  
24 supplies and services needed by the state; and

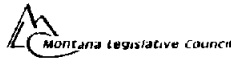
25 (b) sell, trade, or otherwise dispose of surplus

1 supplies belonging to the state.

2 (3) Nothing contained herein shall preclude the state  
3 from doing its own printing on its own printing facilities;  
4 however, the state may not do printing for any person or  
5 entity other than a state agency except under a contract  
6 that has been awarded pursuant to any competitive bidding  
7 requirements applicable to purchases made by that person or  
8 entity."

9 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any  
10 existing authority of the department of administration to  
11 make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is  
12 extended to the provisions of this act.

AGENCIES OR OTHER PERSONS ~~EXCEPT UNDER A CONTRACT AWARDED~~  
~~AFTER COMPETITIVE BIDDING~~; AMENDING SECTION 18-4-221, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 18-4-221, MCA, is amended to read:

"18-4-221. General procurement authority and duties of  
department -- rules. (1) Except as otherwise provided in  
this chapter, the department shall adopt rules, consistent  
with this chapter, governing the procurement and disposal of  
any and all supplies and services to be procured by the  
state. The department shall consider and decide matters of  
policy within the provisions of this chapter. The department  
may audit and monitor the implementation of its rules and  
the requirements of this chapter.

(2) Except as otherwise specifically provided by law,  
the department shall, in accordance with its rules:

(a) procure or supervise the procurement of all  
supplies and services needed by the state; and

(b) sell, trade, or otherwise dispose of surplus

supplies belonging to the state.

(3) Nothing contained herein shall preclude the state  
from doing its own printing on its own printing facilities;  
however, the state INSTITUTIONAL INDUSTRIES DEFINED IN  
53-1-301 may not do printing for any person or entity other  
than a state agency ~~except under a contract that has been~~  
~~awarded pursuant to any competitive bidding requirements~~  
~~applicable to purchases made by that person or entity.~~"
