In compliance with a written request received <u>April 4</u>, <u>19 85</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>Amended H.B. 430</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 430 is an act to establish a voluntary statewide genetics program and to fund the program by a charge on health insurers of 50 cents for each Montana resident insured.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- (1) The actual number of people with health insurance in Montana is unknown.
- (2) The estimated number of Montana residents with health insurance coverage subject to the .50 cent tax in HB 430 is 510,954. This figure assumes only one coverage per person. People may have health insurance coverage under more than one policy and the .50 cent tax would apply to each policy. Based on this methodology the revenue estimated may be understated.
- (3) The estimated number of people in Montana with health insurance does not include people covered by self-insurance programs of cities and courties.
- (4) Assume no additional expenditures to the State Auditor's office.
