Section 69-7-101, MCA, is amended to read: 10 "69-7-101. Municipal utilities -- regulation by 11 municipality -- limitation. A municipality has the power and 12 authority to regulate, establish, and change, as it 13 considers proper, rates, charges, and classifications 14 imposed for utility services to its inhabitants and other 15 persons served by municipal utility systems. Rates, charges, 16 and classifications shall be reasonable and just and, except 17 as provided in 69-7-102, they may not be raised to yield 18 more than a=12 an  $8\frac{8}{2}$  increase in total annual revenues or, 19 in the case of mandated federal and state capital 20 improvements, the increase may not exceed amounts necessary 21 meet the requirements of bond indentures or loan 22 to agreements required to finance the local government's share 23 of the mandated improvements. Annual revenues must be 24 computed on any consecutive 12-month period for purposes of

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this chapter." 1

2 Section 2. Section 69-7-102, MCA, is amended to read: "69-7-102. Rate increases over maximum. (1) If a ٦ 4 municipal utility requires rate increases that yield an increase in total revenues in excess of 12% 8% in any one 5 year or rate increases for mandated federal and state б capital improvements for which the increase exceeds amounts 7 necessary to meet the requirements of bond indentures or я loan agreements required to finance the local government's 9 share of the mandated improvements, it must make application 10 for such increases to the public service commission. 11

12 (2) If the public service commission issues a rate order approving such an increase, the municipality may not 13 increase any rates and charges under this chapter within 12 14 months of the commission's order unless an increase is 15 necessary to meet the requirements of bond indentures or 16 loan agreements required to finance the local government's 17 18 share for mandated federal and state capital improvements." -End-
