In compliance with a written request received <u>January 25</u>, 19 <u>85</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 463</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 463 would submit to the qualified electors of Montana an amendment to Article XIII, Section 3 of the Montana Constitution, which would repeal that portion of the Constitution that requires the Legislature to create a salary commission to recommend compensation for the judiciary and elected members of the legislative and executive branches.

FISCAL IMPACT:

None in the 87 Biennium.

LONG TERM IMPACT:

The Legislative Council had a \$3,000 appropriation for the FY 85 biennium, and has recommended \$3,300 for the FY 87 biennium. Approximately \$3,000 would be saved each biennium if the proposed legislation is passed and if the electorate votes to eliminate the function.
