11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Section 53-1-302, MCA, is amended to read:

13 "53-1-302. Disposition of receipts from sale of goods.
14 Receipts from the sale of goods produced or manufactured by
15 an institution shall be deposited in the internal service
16 fund for the use of the industries program of the
17 institution. ~~At the end of each biennium, all unobligated~~
18 ~~funds over a \$50,000 ending fund balance, except for those~~
19 ~~funds reserved for equipment replacement as determined by an~~
20 ~~equipment replacement schedule, shall revert to the state~~
21 ~~general fund."~~

22 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
23 existing authority of the department of institutions to make
24 rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is
25 extended to the provisions of this act.

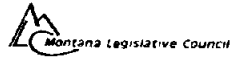
