 4    A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE  
 5    DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO FURNISH THE DIRECTOR OF  
 6    SELECTIVE SERVICE WITH LISTS OF MALE DRIVER'S LICENSE  
 7    HOLDERS BORN IN SPECIFIED YEARS; AMENDING SECTION 2-6-109,  
 8    MCA."

10    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11            Section 1. Section 2-6-109, MCA, is amended to read:  
 12            "2-6-109. Prohibition on distribution or sale of  
 13    mailing lists -- penalty. (1) Except as provided in  
 14    subsections (3), ~~(4)~~, ~~(5)~~, ~~and (6)~~ through (7), in order to  
 15    protect the privacy of those who deal with state and local  
 16    government:

17            (a) no agency may distribute or sell for use as a  
 18    mailing list any list of persons without first securing the  
 19    permission of those on the list; and

20            (b) no list of persons prepared by the agency may be  
 21    used as a mailing list except by the agency or another  
 22    agency without first securing the permission of those on the  
 23    list.

24            (2) As used in this section, "agency" means any board,  
 25    bureau, commission, department, division, authority, or

1    officer of the state or a local government.

2            (3) This section does not prevent an individual from  
 3    compiling a mailing list by examination of original  
 4    documents or applications which are otherwise open to public  
 5    inspection.

6            (4) This section does not apply to the lists of  
 7    registered electors and the new voter lists provided for in  
 8    13-2-115 and 13-38-103, or to lists of the names of  
 9    employees governed by Title 39, chapter 31.

10            (5) This section shall not prevent an agency from  
 11    providing a list to persons providing prelicensing or  
 12    continuing educational courses subject to Title 20, chapter  
 13    30, or specifically exempted therefrom as provided in  
 14    20-30-102.

15            (6) This section does not apply to the right of access  
 16    either by Montana law enforcement agencies or, by purchase  
 17    or otherwise, of public records dealing with motor vehicle  
 18    registration.

19            (7) This section does not apply to a request from the  
 20    director of selective service to the department of justice,  
 21    division of motor vehicles, for a list of males born in  
 22    specified years who are holders of driver's licenses for the  
 23    purpose of assuring compliance with the national selective  
 24    service law.

Description of Proposed Legislation:


House Bill 502 is an act authorizing the Division of Motor Vehicles to furnish the Director of Selective Service with lists of male driver's license holders born in specific years.
