

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated \$350,000 to the Department of Administration for the purchase of real property located in or near the city of Fort Benton, Montana, to be developed as the Montana Agricultural Center and Museum of the Northern Great Plains. The money is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30,
