4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION
5 7-6-4302, MCA, TO ALLOW CITIES AND TOWNS TO PAY ACCOUNTS AND
6 DEMANDS BY CHECK."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 7-6-4302, MCA, is amended to read:

10 "7-6-4302. Payment of claims by warrant or check.
11 Except as provided in 7-6-4121, all accounts and demands
12 against a city or town must be submitted to the council and,
13 if found correct, must be allowed and an order must be made
14 that the demand be paid. The demand must be paid in
15 accordance with one of the following options:

16 (1) The mayor must may draw a warrant upon the
17 treasury in favor of the owner, specifying for what purpose
18 and by what authority it is issued and out of what funds it
19 is to be paid. The city treasurer or town clerk must pay the
20 warrant out of the proper fund.

21 (2) The city treasurer or town clerk may pay the
22 demand by check when there are sufficient city funds on
23 deposit in an interest-bearing checking account in a bank
24 within the city or town that are available to cover the
25 check."
