DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill is an act to compensate members of the State Library Commission \$50.00 per day for each day spent performing actual and necessary board duties.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Current member of the State Library Commission will serve through the 1986-87 biennium.
- 2. Under 2-15-124 MCA, four members of the State Library Commission are entitled to compensation and three members are not.
- 3. Members of the State Library Commission will be engaged in board duties for ten days each fiscal year.
- 4. The effective date of H.B. 576 will be July 1, 1985.
