In compliance with a written request received February 4, 19 85, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for H.B. 576 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill is an act to compensate members of the State Library Commission \$50.00 per day for each day spent performing actual and necessary board duties.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Current member of the State Library Commission will serve through the 1986-87 biennium.
2. Under 2-15-124 MCA, four members of the State Library Commission are entitled to compensation and three members are not.
3. Members of the State Library Commission will be engaged in board duties for ten days each fiscal year.
4. The effective date of H.B. 576 will be July 1, 1985.
