Following: "be a"
Insert: "registered"

2. Page 1, line 12.
Following: "registered"
Insert: "professional"

3. Page 1, lines 12 and 13.
Following: "surveyor"
Strike: remainder of line 12 through "age," on line 13

4. Page 1, line 18.
Following: "practice."
Insert: "However, if the county surveyor position requires the performance of duties under 7-4-2812, the county surveyor must be a registered professional engineer."
