A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AN AGE

5 RESTRICTION ON ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT AS A VOLUNTEER

FIREFIGHTER; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Volunteer firefighter age restriction. The state of Montana determines that age is a valid, bona fide, occupational qualification for the position of volunteer firefighter because of the rigorous demands of fighting fires. Therefore, no volunteer firefighter may be more than 40 years of age at the time of original appointment to a volunteer fire department, brigade, or company. A transfer from a volunteer fire department, brigade, or company to another volunteer fire department, brigade, or company is not an original appointment.

Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective onpassage and approval.
