- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
- Section 1. Section 7-2-4503, MCA, is amended to read:

 "7-2-4503. Restrictions on annexation power. Land
 shall not be annexed under this part whenever the land is
 used:
 - (1) for <u>an</u> agricultural, mining, smelting, <u>or</u> refining, transportation, or any industrial or manufacturing purpose; or
 - (2) for the purpose of maintaining or operating a golf or country club, an athletic field or aircraft landing field, a cemetery, or a place for public or private outdoor entertainment or any purpose incident thereto."
- Section 2. Section 7-2-4504, MCA, is amended to read:

 "7-2-4504. What constitutes contiquous lands -- wholly



- surrounded lands. (1) Tracts or parcels of land proposed to
 be annexed to a city or town under the provisions of this
 part shall be deemed contiguous to such city or town even
 though such tracts or parcels of land may be separated from
 such city or town by a street or other roadway, irrigation
 ditch, drainage ditch, stream, river, or a strip of
 unplatted land too narrow or too small to be platted.
 - (2) For the purposes of this part, land used for transportation purposes is considered wholly surrounded if the external boundary of the land identified in the resolution to annex is at least 50% contiguous with the city boundary."
