10 Section 1. Section 61-12-701, MCA, is amended to read: 11 "61-12-701. Highway-patrol----disposition Disposition 12 of fines and forfeitures. (1) All fines and forfeitures collected in any court from-persons-apprehended-or--arrested 13 14 by--patrolmen for violation of the laws and regulations relating to the use of state highways and the operation of 15 vehicles thereon, if the apprehension or arrest was by a 16 17 highway patrolman, must be paid to the state treasurer and 18 by him credited to the general fund of the state or, if the apprehension or arrest was by a sheriff or deputy sheriff, 19 must be paid to the county treasurer for deposit in the 20 county general fund, except for that portion of the fines 21 22 otherwise allocated by law which shall must be paid into the appropriate accounts in the state special revenue fund. 23

24 (2) At the time of payment of any-such the fine or
 25 forfeiture, there shall must be filed with the state



1 <u>appropriate</u> treasurer a complete statement showing the total 2 of the fines or forfeitures received or incurred, which 3 statement-shall-give giving the title of the court and 4 cause, and be subscribed to by the person or officer making 5 the payments."
