(2) Each member of the board in all other counties is entitled to a salary of-not-more-than-\$50 for each day in which he is actually and necessarily engaged in the performance of board duties as set by resolution of the board. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1985, the salary is \$75 \$60 a day. Thereafter, on or before July 1 of each year, the county commission shall fix a cost-of-living adjusted daily salary by adding to the amount of \$75 \$60 an

increment calculated as provided in 7-4-2504.

The person or persons making the inspections authorized by 7-14-2125 shall receive the--sum--of--\$33-per-day a daily salary equal to that established in 7-4-2107(2) and actual expenses if he receives no other compensation for that day and is not on an annual salary. The claims shall be audited and allowed in the same manner as other claims against the county."

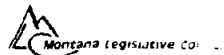
