A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING THE BOARD OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO PRESCRIBE A SALARY SCHEDULE FOR THE PROFESSIONAL FACULTY AND STAFF OF THE MONTANA SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF AND BLIND THAT IS EQUAL TO THE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR TEACHERS AND STAFF OF THE LARGEST SCHOOL DISTRICT IN CASCADE COUNTY THAT HAVE SIMILAR CERTIFICATION, TRAINING, EXPERIENCE, AND DUTIES AS THE PROFESSIONAL FACULTY AND STAFF OF THE SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF AND BLIND; PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION FOR UPGRADING THE SALARY SCHEDULE; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Salary schedule for staff. When prescribing compensation for the professional faculty and staff of the Montana school for the deaf and blind as provided in 20-8-103, the board of public education shall:

(1) review the salary schedule of the largest school district in Cascade county, where the Montana school for the deaf and blind is located, to determine the salary of each certified teacher or noncertified staff member of the school district that has the same or substantially similar certification, training, experience, and duties as a

professional faculty or staff member of the Montana school for the deaf and blind; and

(2) prescribe a salary schedule for the professional faculty and staff of the Montana school for the deaf and blind that is equal to the salary schedule for certified teachers and noncertified staff of the school district as determined in subsection (1).

Section 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated \$150,000 for each year of the biennium ending June 30, 1987, from the general fund to the Board of Public Education for upgrading the salary schedule for the professional faculty and staff of the Montana School for the Deaf and Blind.

Section 3. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the board of public education to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

Section 4. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 20, chapter 8, part 1, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter 8, part 1, apply to section 1.

Section 5. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.
