In compliance with a written request received <u>February 5</u>, <u>19</u><u>85</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 663</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 663 designates the route between the Clearwater Junction and Bigfork as the Seely Swan Scenic Highway and requires the Department of State Lands to prepare a landscape management plan. ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The Department of State Lands will be required to prepare a landscape management plan of the property adjoining the highway from the Clearwater Junction to Bigfork in sufficient detail to preserve and enhance the scenic beauty of the route.
- 2. The Department of State Lands will be required to conduct hearings during the preparation of the plan.

The Department of State Lands will be required to provide landscaping advise to landowners adjoining the highway.
 The Department of Highways is not effected fiscally by the proposed legislation.
