## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 674 directs the Department of Highways to erect signs that identify mountain ranges and prominent geographical features.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Assume signs will be erected that identify mountain ranges, lakes and major drainages.
- 2. From maps available, the Department of Highways estimates about 900 sites where signs would be required in addition to existing signs. Assume two signs at each location.
- 3. Assume cost of erection and fabrication of signs is \$140/sign.
- 4. Assume project will be completed over a 2 year period.
