
In compliance with a written request received February 07, 19 85, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 675 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 675 requires issuance of commemorative centennial plates for a fee of \$25, with proceeds of the sales to go to the county general fund; and provides for applicability to vehicle registrations after December 31, 1986.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. It is estimated that the number requesting centennial plates will be similar to the number of requests for personalized plates.
2. There are approximately 38,000 personalized plates. There will be approximately 8,000 new requests in subsequent years.
3. A manual process is necessary for review and processing of applications.
4. The cost of manufacturing the centennial plates will be the responsibility of the Department of Institutions (State Prison).
5. 38,000 sets of centennial plates will be produced in FY 87.
6. The shipping of centennial plates to the counties will be similar to the method used to ship personalized plates.
7. Funding for the plates is from the Motor Vehicle Account.

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NOTE: Revenues to counties will be dependent on the number of centennial plates requested. Realistically, that number will be less than 38,000 in FY 87. Potential revenue in subsequent years based on 8,000 new requests is \$200,000.

TECHNICAL NOTE:

Appropriation requests from the Motor Vehicle Account at this time do not allow a sufficient fund balance in FY 87 to support this bill.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15 Section 1. Centennial license plate -- county
16 designation. (1) The division shall design and manufacture
17 a special license plate to commemorate the centennial
18 anniversary of the admission of the state of Montana to the
19 union. The centennial plate must be issued and used as
20 provided in [sections 2 through 4].

21 (2) The centennial plate must bear the appropriate
22 county designation pursuant to 61-3-332.

23 Section 2. Centennial license plates authorized. Any
24 person who is the registered owner of a motor vehicle,
25 truck, motor home, camping trailer, motorcycle, or other

1 vehicle for the owner's personal use registered with the
2 division or who makes application for original registration
3 of a motor vehicle may upon payment of the fee prescribed in
4 [section 4] apply to the division for centennial license
5 plates in the manner prescribed in [section 3], which plates
6 must be affixed to the motor vehicle for which registration
7 is sought in lieu of the regular license plates provided for
8 in this chapter.

9 Section 3. Application for centennial plates. An
10 applicant for centennial license plates or renewal of
11 centennial plates in subsequent years pursuant to [sections
12 2 through 4] shall file an application therefor in the form
13 and by the date the division requires.

14 Section 4. Fees for centennial plates -- disposition.
15 (1) In addition to all other fees and taxes imposed by law,
16 the applicant for a centennial license plate shall pay a fee
17 of \$25 for the original centennial license plate and a fee
18 of \$5 for each transfer or renewal thereof.

19 (2) ~~(A) The county treasurer shall deposit all revenue~~
20 ~~from the fees to the county general fund. THE \$25 FEE~~
21 ~~PROVIDED FOR IN SUBSECTION (1) MUST BE DEPOSITED. AS FOLLOWS:~~

22 (I) \$5 IN THE MOTOR VEHICLE RECORDING ACCOUNT OF THE
23 STATE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND;

24 (II) \$10 IN THE ACCOUNT OF THE MONTANA STATEHOOD
25 CENTENNIAL OFFICE PROVIDED FOR IN [HOUSE BILL NO. [LC

1 1078||; AND

2 (III) \$10 IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE COUNTY ISSUING THE
3 PLATE.

4 (B) THE \$5 FEE PROVIDED FOR IN SUBSECTION (1) MUST BE
5 DEPOSITED INTO THE MOTOR VEHICLE RECORDING ACCOUNT OF THE
6 STATE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND.

7 Section 5. Extension of authority. Any existing
8 authority of the department of justice, division of motor
9 vehicles, to make rules on the subject of the provisions of
10 this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

11 Section 6. Codification instruction. Sections 1
12 through 4 are intended to be codified as an integral part of
13 Title 61, chapter 3, part 4, and the provisions of Title 61,
14 chapter 3, apply to sections 1 through 4.

15 Section 7. Applicability. Sections 2 through 4 apply
16 to registrations of motor vehicles for years following
17 December 31, 1986.

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
