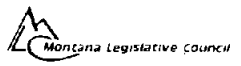

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 12 Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the
 13 Department of Administration \$64,000 from the general fund
 14 to pay all unsatisfied claims of Vision Quest against the
 15 State of Montana arising out of the placement of James
 16 Romero, No. 929-J, First Judicial District Youth Court
 17 proceeding. The Department shall obtain a comprehensive
 18 release of all claims, including costs and attorney fees,
 19 before payment of the sum appropriated in this section.
 20 Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on
 21 passage and approval.
