
DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 710 authorizes the Department of Justice, Motor Vehicle Division, to issue an identification card to a person whose driver's license is suspended.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact to the Department of Justice.

Note: There are about 1,000 drivers suspended each year which this legislation affects. It is unknown how many would want an identification card. The Motor Vehicle Division will charge for the cost of the ID cards (\$1.00) as they do now. The Motor Vehicle Division will absorb the increased workload.

12 authorized to issue identification cards to any person over
13 the age of 18 years:

14 (1) who is not the holder of a valid driver's license;
15 or
16 (2) whose driver's license is suspended pursuant--to
17 61-5-206."

18 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
19 existing authority of the department of justice, division of
20 motor vehicles, to make rules on the subject of the
21 provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this
22 act.
