DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 710 authorizes the Department of Justice, Motor Vehicle Division, to issue an identification card to a erson whose driver's license is suspended.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact to the Department of Justice.

Note: There are about 1,000 drivers suspended each year which this legislation affects. It is unknown how many would want an identification card. The Motor Vehicle Division will charge for the cost of the ID cards (\$1.00) as they do now. The Motor Vehicle Division will absorb the increased workload.
