In compliance with a written request received February 9 19 85 , there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for H.B. 734 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

To prohibit the possession of both a class A-5 and class A-7 elk license in the same year and increase the class A-7 tag to \$10.00.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- The A-7 tag will be issued to harvest elk causing game damage.
- 2. The issuance of the A-7 license will replace current department procedures for damage caused by elk.
- The administrative costs for the A-7 tag will be absorbed in current level.
- The A-7 license will be issued in exchange for the A-5 license, therefore no revenue impact will occur.

If the above assumptions are used there is no fiscal impact to the bill as written.
