WHEREAS, participation in the National Water Resources Association brings benefits to all Montanans who use water.

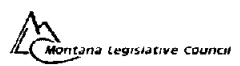
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
