"19-9-601. Member contributions. The treasurer or other appropriate official of each employer shall retain from the monthly compensation of each active member a sum equal to 6% 7% or, in the case of a member first employed by an employer as a police officer after June 30, 1979, 7-1/2% 8 1/2% of his monthly compensation, excluding overtime, holiday payments, shift differential payments, compensation time payments, and payments in lieu of sick leave and annual leave, for his services as a police officer. The monthly deduction from the salaries of police officers shall be paid to the administrator for the purpose of paying the retirement allowances of retired police officers."

Section 3. Section 19-9-702, MCA, is amended to read:

"19-9-702. State contribution. The state of Montana shall make its contributions through the state auditor out of the premium tax on motor vehicle property and casualty insurance policies. Such payments shall be made annually after the end of each fiscal year but no later than September 1 from the gross premium tax after deduction for cancellations and returned premiums. The administrator shall notify the auditor by April 1 of each year of the annual compensation paid to all active members during the preceding year. Before July 1, 1985, the state's contribution shall be 14.04% of such compensation and 15-06% 23.86% on and after July 1, 1985."

### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 754 provides for allowance adjustments to police officers retired after July 1, 1975 or their beneficiaries. ASSUMPTIONS:

1. 2% salary adjustments per year.

Increase in Employee Contributions 19

- 2. 145 retirees not receiving allowance adjustments (these are retirees since July 1, 1975).
- 3. FY 84 average adjustment of \$3,810 per retiree/yr. for people who retired prior to July 1, 1975.

In compliance with a written request received April 11, 19 85, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for H.B. 754 Amended pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

As amended HB 754 would provide an allowance adjustment for members of the Municipal Police Officers' retirement system retired on or after July 1, 1975, but before July 1, 1985, or their beneficiaries; providing funding for the adjustment; and providing an effective date.

### ASSUMPTIONS:

- (1) Only retirees with 20 years of service or more as a police officer will receive the adjustment unless they retired for disability or the benefit is on account of death.
- (2) 73 retirees eligible
- (3) Average benefit increase/retiree of \$1,644/year, based on the 7-1-84 actuarial valuation.
