(1) The trustees of 14 any district may propose to adopt a general fund budget in 15 excess of the general fund budget amount for such district 16 as established by the schedules in 20-9-316 through 20-9-321 17 for any of the following purposes: 18 (a) building, altering, repairing, or enlarging any 19 schoolhouse of the district: 20 (b) furnishing additional school facilities for the 21 district: 22 (c) acquisition of land for the district: (d) proper maintenance and operation of the school 23 24 programs of the district.

(2) When the trustees of any district determine that

an additional amount of financing is required for the general fund budget that is in excess of the statutory schedule amount, the trustees shall submit the proposition of an additional levy to raise such excess amount of general fund financing to the electors who are qualified under 20-20-301 to vote upon such proposition except that no election shall be required to permit the school trustees to use federal funds received under Title I of Public Law 81-874 to increase the school district's general fund budget as established in 20-9-316 through 20-9-321 by the amount of 10 11 these funds. Such special election shall be called and 12 conducted in the manner prescribed by this title for school elections. The ballot for such election shall state the 13 14 amount of money to be raised by additional property 15 taxation, the approximate number of mills required to raise 16 such money, and the purpose for which such money will be 17 expended, and it shall be in the following format: 18 PROPOSITION
