BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-4-2509, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-4-2509. Sheriff's department -- work period in lieu
of workweek -- overtime compensation. (1) (a) A sheriff's
department may establish a work period other than the
workweek provided in 39-3-405 or 7-32-2111 for determining
when an employee may be paid overtime.

- (b) The aggregate of all work periods in a year, when expressed in hours, may not exceed 2,080 hours.
- 19 (2) The board of county commissioners may---by
 20 resolution shall establish that any undersheriff or deputy
 21 sheriff who works in excess of his regularly scheduled work
 22 period will be compensated for the hours worked in excess of
 23 the work period at a rate to-be-determined-by-that-board-of
