0	WHEREAS, the Montana Health Information Center has been
1	developed to provide a central access point for providing
2	consumer-oriented health information to lay persons and
3	health professionals on physical and mental diseases,
4	disorders, and concerns; and
5	WHEREAS, the Montana Health Information Center
6	disseminates information on the many groups, organizations,
7	and health care specialists available to comfort, diagnose,
8	treat, or otherwise assist and inform persons regarding
9	health problems; and
0	WHEREAS, the Montana Health Information Center handled
1	over 6,000 requests for information from Montanans in 1984,
2	its first year in operation; and
3	WHEREAS, there is a demonstrable need for this
4	information to continue to be available to lay persons and
5	health care professionals on a current basis; and

1	whereas, the Legislature intends to continue the
2	Montana Health Information Center to assure statewide access
3	to current health information.

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
6	Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated
7	\$50,000 for fiscal year 1986 and \$30,000 for fiscal year
В	1987 from the general fund to the Department of Health and
9	Environmental Sciences for the purposes of health
10	information services as provided in 50-16-401.
11	Section 2. Repealer. Section 50-16-401, MCA, is
12	repealed.
13	Section 3. Effective date. Section 2 is effective July
