 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Statewide raffles by certain organizations
 10 authorized. (1) The conducting of statewide raffles by
 11 nonprofit service, civic, fraternal, religious, and
 12 charitable organizations and participating in the raffles is
 13 lawful, and the raffles are exempt from the provisions of
 14 part 2 of this chapter. They are also exempt from the
 15 provisions of this part, except that 23-5-402(1)(b) and
 16 (2)(b), 23-5-416, and 23-5-423 apply.

17 (2) Each raffle must be licensed by the secretary of
 18 state upon payment of a license fee in an amount
 19 commensurate with the cost of processing and issuing the
 20 license.

21 (3) A person who knowingly violates this section or a
 22 provision of this part applying to statewide raffles commits
 23 a criminal offense and may be fined not to exceed \$1,000,
 24 imprisoned in the county jail not to exceed 3 months, or
 25 both.

1 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is
 2 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 23,
 3 chapter 5, part 4, but the only provisions of part 4 that
 4 apply to section 1 are 23-5-402(1)(b) and (2)(b), 23-5-416,
 5 and 23-5-423.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Statewide raffles by certain organizations
11 authorized. (1) The conducting of statewide raffles by
12 nonprofit ORGANIZATIONS EXEMPT FROM TAXATION UNDER
13 15-31-102(1)(A), (1)(B), AND (1)(D) THROUGH (1)(G),
14 INCLUDING service, civic, fraternal, religious, and
15 charitable organizations, and participating in the raffles
16 is lawful, and the raffles are exempt from the provisions of
17 part 2 of this chapter. They are also exempt from the
18 provisions of this part, except that 23-5-402(1)(b) and
19 (2)(b), 23-5-416, and 23-5-423 apply.

20 (2) Each raffle must be licensed by the secretary of
21 state upon payment of a license fee in an amount
22 commensurate with the cost of processing and issuing the
23 license.

24 (3) A person who knowingly violates this section or a
25 provision of this part applying to statewide raffles commits

1 a criminal offense and may be fined not to exceed \$1,000,
2 imprisoned in the county jail not to exceed 3 months, or
3 both.

4 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is
5 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 23,
6 chapter 5, part 4, but the only provisions of part 4 that
7 apply to section 1 are 23-5-402(1)(b) and (2)(b), 23-5-416,
8 and 23-5-423.
