INTRODUCED BY

BY REQUEST OF THE HOUSE STATE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROHIBITING EMPLOYEES
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE WHOSE ASSIGNED DUTIES INVOLVE
APPRAISING OR ASSESSING PROPERTY FROM ENGAGING IN CERTAIN
ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE THEIR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT; AND
PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Prohibited activities for certain
department of revenue employees. (1) An employee of the
department of revenue whose assigned duties involve
appraising or assessing property for ad valorem tax purposes
may not perform an appraisal for a fee or other
compensation, sell real estate, or act as a real estate
broker outside his employment with the department unless
such activity involves his own property.

(2) An employee who violates subsection (1) is subject
to discipline or termination in the manner provided by rule
or law.

Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on
passage and approval.
