5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROHIBITING EMPLOYEES

8 ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE THEIR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT; AND  
9 PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 DEPARTMENT STATE; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE  
12 DATE."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15           Section 1. Prohibited activities for certain  
16 department--of--revenue STATE employees. (1) An employee of  
17 the department--of--revenue STATE whose assigned duties  
18 involve appraising or assessing property ~~for-ad-valorem-tax~~  
19 purposes may not perform an appraisal for a fee or other  
20 compensation, sell real estate, or act as a real estate  
21 broker outside his employment with the department STATE  
22 unless such activity involves his own property.

23 (2) An employee who violates subsection (1) is subject  
24 to discipline or termination in the manner provided by rule  
25 or law.

1           Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on  
2 passage and approval.
