In compliance with a written request received February 19 , 19 85, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 860 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

Description of Proposed Legislation:

The project would establish a Natural Resource Information System that would inventory existing data and information collected and stored by state agencies and design a mechanism to provide access to this decentralized system. The bill would authorize the State Library to implement and operate the Natural Resource Information System and the Natural Heritage Program.

## Assumptions:

- 1. This is a housekeeping bill transferring statutory responsibility from Department of Administration to the State Library Commission.
- 2. The program, as statutorily authorized, was not funded by the 48th Legislature.
- 3. Fiscal impact will be incorporated in fiscal notes attached to any appropriations bills.
- 4. The State Library Commission will not implement the program and will not incur expenses unless appropriations bills provide funds for the program.

Fiscal Impact:

Local Impact:

Cost saving or cost avoidance for local counties and other local government units.

Long-range Impacts:

Cost avoidance for agencies which review environmental impact statements and applications under the Facilities Siting Act or in other ways use natural resource information.
