BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 3-15-701, MCA, is amended to read:
"3-15-701. When and by whom jurors summoned. (1) When
jurors are required for a civil trial in any justice's or
city court or any other court of limited jurisdiction, they
must, upon the order of the justice or of the judge thereof,
be summoned by the sheriff, constable, marshal, or policeman
of the jurisdiction.

(2) When jurors are required for a criminal trial in any justice's or city court or other court of limited jurisdiction, they must, upon order of the justice or the judge, be served notice by mail that they are summoned. If a person fails to respond to the notice, the justice or judge shall certify the failure to the sheriff, constable, marshal, or policeman of the jurisdiction, who shall summon them personally."

25 Section 2. Section 3-15-702, MCA, is amended to read:



"3-15-702. How to be summoned. Such jurors must be summoned from the persons competent to serve as jurors, residents of the county, city, or town in which such court has jurisdiction, by notifying them orally for a civil trial or by mail for a criminal trial that they are summoned and of the time and place at which their attendance is required."

8 Section 3. Section 3-15-703, MCA, is amended to read:
9 "3-15-703. Officer's return. (1) The officer summoning
10 the jurors for a civil trial shall, at the time fixed in the
