BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 15-50-205, MCA, is amended to read:

"15-50-205. Additional license tax imposed. (1) In
addition to the fees enumerated in 37-71-204, each public
contractor, unless he constructs or works on a federal
research facility, shall pay to the department of revenue an
additional license fee in a sum equal to 1% of the gross
receipts, as defined in 37-71-101, from public contracts
during the income year for which the license is issued.

(2) The additional license fee shall be computed upon the basis of the entire contract for each separate contract let by any of the public bodies as specified in 37-71-101(4)."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of revenue to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is

extended to the provisions of this act.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Applicability. This act applies to any public contract entered into before, on, or after the effective date of this act, except that any tax already paid to the department of revenue may not be returned to the contractor.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. This act is
 effective on passage and approval.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act exempting a public contractor who constructs or works on a federal research facility from the additional license tax imposed on public contractors.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total fiscal impact of the proposal cannot be estimated because the allocation of federal funds for research facilities cannot be fully anticipated. However, over \$300,000 in public contractors gross receipts taxes are outstanding for construction of the MHD facility. An additional \$1.5 million of construction at the MHD facility. yielding taxes of \$15,000, is anticipated over the next 3 years.
