DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to update the statute regarding Capitol renovation; to remove the requirement that the Senate Chambers remain in their current location; amending section 2-17-109, MCA; and providing an immediate effective date.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Department of Administration has reported to the Capitol Building and Planning Committee on the status of the Capitol remodeling project.

The Department and the project architects will provide any information needed once they receive direction from the Committee. Until that time a realistic estimate is not possible.


