A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$750,000
IN FISCAL YEAR 1985 AND \$450,000 IN FISCAL YEAR 1986 FROM
COAL BOARD FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR
ENFORCEMENT OF LAWS RELATING TO DRUGS AND STOLEN GOODS; AND
PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation of local impact funds for
drug law enforcement. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of
90-6-205 through 90-6-207 and 90-6-209, there is
appropriated to the department of justice from the funds
authorized in 90-6-205 for coal board grants and loans:

- (a) \$750,000 in fiscal year 1985; and
- (b) \$450,000 in fiscal year 1986.

(2) The department of justice shall expend the money
appropriated in subsection (1) for statewide enforcement of
the provisions of 45-6-301 through 45-6-304 and Title 45,
chapters 9 and 10, and investigation of violations of those
provisions.

Section 2. Retention of unexpended balance.
Notwithstanding the provisions of 17-7-304, any portion of
the appropriations in section 1 unexpended at the end of the

fiscal year in which appropriated is available during the
next and succeeding fiscal years to the department of
justice for the purposes provided in section 1.

Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective on
passage and approval.
