12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
13	Section 1. Section 44-10-103, MCA, is amended to read
14	"44-10-103. Establishment of academy. There is hereby
15	established a Montana law enforcement academy to be located
16	at one-of-the-units-of-the-Montana-university-system7-which
17	unit-shall-be-selected-in-the-manner-hereinafter-provided on
18	near Lewistown, Montana."
19	Section 2. Section 44-10-202, MCA, is amended to read:
20	"44-10-202. Powers and duties of department. The
21	department of justice shall have the power and it shall be
22	its duty to:
23	(1) choose a <u>suitable</u> site for the Montana law
24	enforcement academy at the unit-of-the university-system-of
25	Montana-which-in-the-determination-of-the-department-is-best

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Criteria for selection of academy site. In choosing a suitable site for the Montana law enforcement academy as required under 44-10-202, the department of justice shall consider only those properties of substantial acreage containing structures and buildings of sufficient capacity to provide:

- 11 (1) administrative offices;
- 12 (2) dormitories;

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- (3) a classroom and training building;
- 14 (4) an athletic facility;
- 15 (5) an indoor firing range; and
- 16 (6) other facilities that meet the needs of the 17 academy.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Appropriation. There is appropriated from available cash revenues in the capital project fund to the Department of Justice for the biennium ending June 30, 1987, the sum of \$2,165,000, to be used for the purpose of acquiring land and structures suitable for location of the Montana Law Enforcement Academy as required under 44-10-202.
