In compliance with a written request received March 3, 19 85, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for H.B. 943 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 943 is an act to increase the fee for issuance or renewal of a teacher or specialist certificate from the current \$2 to \$5 for each school fiscal year that the certificate will be valid and a \$2 filing fee for issuance of initial certificates.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The number of certificates that will be issued this fiscal year will be 1,400 class 1, 2, 3, 4, 6; 1,500 class 5, and 3,170 renewals.
- 2. The volume of certificates issued each year will remain constant for the next few years after which a gradual increase will begin.
- 3. Certificates are issued for a period of 5 years.
