23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Procedure for change of 24 boundary. (1) The question of whether the boundaries of 25 Granite and Missoula Counties shall be changed as provided

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1 in sections 1 and 2 shall be placed on the ballots of each 2 county at a date determined by a joint meeting of the boards 3 of county commissioners of Granite and Missoula Counties. If 4 approved by a majority of those voting on the question in 5 each of the counties, the boundaries as amended in sections 6 1 and 2 are effective 120 days after the date of the 7 election.

8 (2) If the change of boundaries is approved by the 9 electorate, officials and employees of Granite and Missoula 10 Counties shall cooperate to effect an orderly, expeditious, 11 and fair transition for the boundary change. Provisions 12 relating to county records, indebtedness, liabilities, 13 assets, and taxation shall be as provided in Title 7, 14 chapter 2, part 1, and 7-2-2102.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Administration \$1,000 from the general fund for distribution to the Counties of Granite and Missoula, based upon the number of persons in each county voting on the question presented in section 3, to be used for the costs of such election.

1 corner of said section thirty-one (31); thence running west 2 to the guarter corner on the north line of section one (1), 3 township fourteen (14) north, range twenty-three (23) west: 4 thence running south to an intersection with the center of 5 the channel of the Missoula river; thence running in a 6 northwesterly direction, following the center of the channel 7 of the Missoula river to its intersection with the line 8 dividing townships fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) north: 9 thence running west to the northeast corner of section five (5), township fourteen (14) north, range twenty-three (23) 10 11 west: thence running south to the southeast corner of said 12 section five (5); thence running west to the southwest corner of said section five (5); thence running south to the 13 14 southeast corner of section eighteen (18), township fourteen 15 (14) north, range twenty-three (23) west; thence running 16 west to the southwest corner of said section eighteen (18): said point being on the Lo Lo guide meridian; thence running 17 18 south on the Lo Lo guide meridian to the third standard 19 parallel north; thence running east to the northeast corner 20 of section one (1), township twelve (12) north, range twenty-four (24) west; thence running south to the southeast 21 corner of section thirty-six (36), township twelve (12) 22 north, range twenty-four (24) west; thence running west to 23 the northwest corner of section six (6), township eleven 24 25 (11) north, range twenty-four (24) west; thence running

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south to the Montana-Idaho state line; thence running in a 1 2 general southeasterly direction following said line to the intersection with the south line of township eleven (11) 3 north, range twenty-two (22) west; thence running east along 4 the line between townships ten (10) and eleven (11) north, 5 to-an-intersection-with-the-center-of-the--channel--of--Rock 6 creek;--thence--running--in--a-northerly-direction-following 7 down-the-center-of-the-channel-of-Rock-creek-to--the--center 8 9 of--the-channel-of-the-Hell-Gate-river;-thence-running-in-an easterly-direction-up-the-center-of-the-old-original-channel 10 of-said-river-as--the--same--existed--at--the--time--of--the 11 creation--of-Missoula-county,-to-an-intersection-with-a-line 12 projected-due-north-from-the-top-of-Medicine-Pree-hill;-said 13 natural-monument--being--located--in--township--eleven--(11) 14 northy--range--fifteen-fi5}-west;-thence-running-north-along 15 said-line-to-the-top-of-the-divide-between-the-Hell-Gate-and 16 Blackfoot-rivers;-thence-running-in--an--easterly--direction 17 following-the-summit-of-said-divide-to-its-intersection-with 18 the--east-line-of-township-twelve-(12)-northy-range-fourteen 19 +14)-west; to the southeast corner of section 31, township 20 eleven (11) north, range eighteen (18) west, principal 21 meridian, Montana; thence north along the section boundaries 22 to the third standard parallel, principal meridian, Montana; 23 thence east to the southwest corner of section 36, township 24 thirteen (13) north, range eighteen (18) west, principal 25

meridian, Montana; thence north to the northwest corner of 1 2 said section 36; thence east to the northeast corner of said section 36; thence south along the eastern boundary of 3 4 section 36 to the third standard parallel at the southeast 5 corner of section 36, township thirteen (13) north, range 6 eighteen (18) west, principal meridian, Montana; thence east 7 along the third standard parallel to the range line between 8 range fourteen (14) west and range thirteen (13) west at the 9 southeast corner of township thirteen (13) north, range 10 fourteen (14) west, principal meridian, Montana; thence 11 running north along the line between ranges thirteen (13) 12 and fourteen (14) west, observing the offsets and 13 corrections thereto to the northeast corner of township sixteen (16) north, range fourteen (14) west; thence running 14 15 west along the fourth standard parallel north to an intersection with a line heretofore described as being 16 17 projected due north from the top of Medicine Tree hill; 18 thence running north along said line to an intersection with 19 the south line of the north tier of sections of township 20 twenty-one (21) north, range fifteen (15) west; thence 21 running west along the south line of the north tier of 22 sections of township twenty-one (21) north to the place of 23 beginning. The county seat is Missoula, Montana."

24 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Procedure for change of
 25 boundary. (1) The question of whether the boundaries of

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Granite and Missoula Counties shall be changed as provided 1 2 in sections 1 and 2 shall be placed on the ballots of each county at a date determined by a joint meeting of the boards 3 of county commissioners of Granite and Missoula Counties. If 4 approved by a majority of those voting on the question in 5 each of the counties, the boundaries as amended in sections 6 1 and 2 are effective 120 days after the date of the 7 8 election.

9 (2) If the change of boundaries is approved by the 10 electorate, officials and employees of Granite and Missoula 11 Counties shall cooperate to effect an orderly, expeditious, 12 and fair transition for the boundary change. Provisions 13 relating to county records, indebtedness, liabilities, 14 assets, and taxation shall be as provided in Title 7, 15 chapter 2, part 1, and 7-2-2102.

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 4. Appropriation. There is
17 appropriated to the Department of Administration \$17000 \$1
18 from the general fund for distribution to the Counties of
19 Granite and Missoula, based upon the number of persons in
20 each county voting on the question presented in section 3,
21 to be used for the costs of such election.

22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 5. Effective date. This act is
23 effective on passage and approval.
