10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
11	Section 1. Section 5-2-302, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"5-2-302. Compensation and expenses when legislature
13	not in session. (1) When the legislature is not in session,
14	members of the legislative council, legislative
15	subcommittees, and select and interim committees, while
16	engaged in authorized committee business, are entitled to:
17	(1) a mileage allowance as provided in 2-18-503;
18	(2)(b) expenses as provided in 2-18-501 and 2-18-502;
19	and
20	(3)(c) a salary equal to one full day's pay at the
21	rate of a classified state employee, described in 5-2-301
22	for each 24-hour period of time (from midnight to midnight),
23	or portion thereof, spent away from home on authorized
24	committee business. However, if time spent for business
25	other than authorized committee business results in

1	lengthening a legislator's stay away from home into an
2	additional 24-hour period, he may not be compensated for the
3	additional day.
4	(2) The president elect of the senate or the speaker
5	elect of the house when engaged in presession business as
6	provided in 5-2-202 is entitled to a salary equal to 1 full
7	day's pay at the rate of a classified state employee as
8	described in 5-2-301 for each 24-hour period of time (from
9	midnight to midnight), or portion thereof, spent engaged in
10	presession business. If the business is conducted away from
11	home, the president or speaker is entitled to a mileage
12	allowance as provided in subsection (1)(a) and expenses as
13	provided in subsection (1)(b)."
