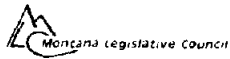
Section 1. Authority to purchase Charles M. Russell collection. The Montana Historical Society may purchase the Charles M. Russell collection of letters, paintings, and sketches belonging to the Elks Lodge of Great Falls, Montana, for a total purchase price not to exceed \$482,000. The Montana Historical Society may solicit and accept gifts and grants to assist in the purchase of this collection.

Section 2. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated \$300,000 from the general fund to the Montana Historical Society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, to be used for the purpose of section 1. The balance of such funds not expended in fiscal year 1985 is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1987, for the same purpose.
