WHEREAS, a determination of the rate for grazing on state school trust lands is a complex and controversial issue; and

WHEREAS, the revenue from grazing fees constitutes a significant source for the support of Montana public schools; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has historically established the formula for grazing fees on school trust lands; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Auditor has recommended that the Board of Land Commissioners raise the grazing rate; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Constitution mandates fair market value for all assets of state land disposed of in Article X, section 11; and

WHEREAS, many factors must be discussed and considered in setting a fair market value for the grazing rates on Montana school trust lands.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

(1) That an appropriate interim committee be assigned to study and determine what the fair market value is for grazing fees on state school trust lands.

(2) That the committee report its findings and recommendations to the 50th Legislature, together with any legislation to implement its recommendations.
