T	HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 46
2	INTRODUCED BY Dardancur
3	BY REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR
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5	A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
6	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING AN
7	INTERIM STUDY TO EXAMINE THE CONSOLIDATION OF ALL PROGRAMS
8	TO ASSIST COMMUNITIES EXPERIENCING IMPACTS RELATED TO
9	NONRENEWABLE RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT.
10	
11	WHEREAS, current state programs for assisting
12	communities impacted by nonrenewable resource development
13	are organized around separate boards for each different kind
14	of natural resource development activity; and
15	WHEREAS, the current programs do not address the broad
16	range of natural resource development issues that exist in
17	Montana; and
18	WHEREAS, proposals before the 49th Legislature would
19	significantly reduce or eliminate funding for the Coal
20	Board; and
21	WHEREAS, a consolidated nonrenewable resource impact
22	program would more efficiently utilize staff and provide a
23	uniform, coordinated, and rational statewide system for
24	assisting developers and communities in dealing with
25	resource development impacts.

2	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
3	OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
4	(1) That an appropriate interim committee be assigned
5	to study the consolidation of programs to assist communities
6	with nonrenewable resource impacts.
7	(2) That the committee include in its study a review
8	of:
9	(a) the effectiveness of current nonrenewable resource
10	impact mitigation programs;
11	(b) adverse impacts suffered by Montana communities as
12	a result of nonrenewable resource development; and
13	(c) the financial resources available to communities
14	that have been or may be impacted by development.
15	(3) That the committee submit to the 50th Legislature
16	a report of its findings and recommendations for

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legislation.

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
