A clerk or deputy who fails to attend the orientation course or an annual training 14 15 session without proper excuse is disgualified from office. 16 (4) The supreme court shall pay each clerk of district 17 court's and deputy clerk of district court's actual and 18 necessary travel expenses as provided in 2-18-501 through 2-18-503 for attending the orientation course and each 19 20 annual training session plus the costs of registration, 21 books, and other materials.

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 27 is an act requiring the Supreme Court Administrator to conduct orientation courses and training sessions for Clerks of District Court, Deputy Clerks of District Court, and persons who perform duties similar to those of the Clerk of District Court for Justices', Municipal and City Courts.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- (1) Between the two annual training sessions, 130 clerks and/or deputies would attend the sessions.
- (2) The statewide average cost per clerk to travel to a session is approximately \$115.00.
- (3) Persons who perform duties similar to those of the Clerk of District Court for Justices', Municipal and City Courts and attend the sessions will claim their expenses from the county.
- (4) Instructor and other program costs \$12,000.
