23 (i) a written request to terminate the security interest, signed by the secured party, on forms provided by the department; and

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1 (ii) a \$10 filing fee.

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- (b) If the signature of a terminating secured party is unattainable, the party requesting termination of the security interest must provide proof of satisfaction of the obligation upon which the security interest rests. No fee is required for terminating the security interest of a foreclosing secured party seeking transfer of ownership.
- (4) The department may not approve the transfer of a license subject to a security interest, attachment, or other valid lien unless the secured party, lienholder, or judgment creditor consents to the transfer or releases the security interest, attachment, or lien. No fee is required for a continuation of a security interest on renewal of a license. This section does not affect rights and remedies established in Titles 25, 27, and 30, MCA.
- Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing 16 authority of the department of revenue to make rules on the 17 subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the 18 provisions of this act.
- 20 Section 3. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 16, 21 chapters 1 through 6, and the provisions of Title 16, 22 chapters 1 through 6, apply to section 1. 23
